ABOUT US

Beginning service in October 1992, Metrolink is Southern California's regional passenger rail network and is governed by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA), a joint powers authority made up of an 11-member board representing the transportation commissions of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura counties. The agency's 545.6 total service line miles and 67 stations across six counties serve as an essential regional link, enabling people to connect to their jobs and explore all that Southern California has to offer. On October 24, 2022, the new Arrow service launched as an extension of the San Bernardino Line, with nine new miles of track and four new stations.
